

NEW STUDENTS FOR KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION
APPLICATION PROCESS
2023-2024 School Year

Please visit the Homepage of our School Website to begin the registration process for our **Kindergarten** 2023-2024 school year. A Kindergarten student must be age five on or before October 1, 2023. If your child was a student at New Hanover Twp. School for our Pre-Kindergarten program you do not need to do anything.

Here are the steps to help you along:

Find the title for Kindergarten 2023-2024. Step one is to open the first link and familiarize yourself with the immunization information and required papers needed. Step two is open the New Kindergarten Parent Questionnaire link and print it off to complete. You will bring this with you on your child's screening date. Step three is to open the Click for Online Registration link and complete that. **Please complete the registration form on a computer, not a cell phone.**

Once you have completed the Online registration you will be called to set up an appointment on May 3 to bring your child in for screening and to complete the paperwork needed for registering.

Reminder to bring the following:

1. CHILD'S BIRTH CERTIFICATE
2. CHILD'S IMMUNIZATION RECORDS
3. PROOF OF RESIDENCY –
 1. For renters: Current signed & dated Lease with signature of tenants and landlord showing actual location of home/apartment. A current Utility bill (dated within the last 3 months) needs to accompany residents who have a Lease. An Affidavit of Domicile form will be provided to you if you reside with someone else. Proof of their residence must be provided in this situation.
 2. For homeowners: Utility bill (dated within last 3 months) OR
 3. For homeowner:-Tax bill (current year) or Deed.
4. YOUR CHILD MUST ATTEND THE DAY OF YOUR APPOINTMENT

According to N.J.A.C. 8.57-4 (Immunization of Pupils in School) the information regarding immunizations is attached for you to review.
