NEW STUDENTS FOR PRE- KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION/SCREENING
APPLICATION PROCESS
2020-2021 School Year

New Hanover Township School located at 122 Fort Dix Street, Wrightstown, NJ will be holding its Pre-Kindergarten lottery drawing for new students on April 7, 2020.

The Questionnaire/Application which can be found on our school's website must be completed online or handed in by April 6, 2020. Parent's will be notified by phone on April 8 or 9, 2020 to schedule their appointments for screening if child is selected.

A Pre-Kindergarten student must be age four on or before October 1, 2020.

If your child is selected, please bring with you the following on April 24 or May 22:

1. CHILD TO BE SCREENED
2. CHILD'S BIRTH CERTIFICATE
3. CHILD'S IMMUNIZATION RECORDS
4. PROOF OF RESIDENCY –
 1. Current signed & dated Lease with signature of tenants and landlord showing actual location of home. A current Utility bill needs to accompany residents who have a Lease. An Affidavit of Domicile form will be provided to you if you reside with someone else. Proof of their residence must be provided also. OR
 2. Utility bill (dated within last 3 months) OR
 3. Homeowners-Tax bill (current year) or Deed.
5. MEDICAL FORM THAT WAS INCLUDED IN ONLINE REGISTRATION PACKET

Immunizations

According to N.J.A.C. 8.57-4 (Immunization of Pupils in School) the following immunizations must be up to date prior to beginning school in September:

1. Five doses DPT, one of which must be administered after the 4th birthday,
2. Four doses of Inactivated Poliovirus (IPV) vaccine, one of which must be administered after the 4th birthday.
3. Two doses of the Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) vaccine are required, one dose must be administered after 4th birthday.
4. Haemophilus influenza type b (Hib) vaccine
5. One dose of Varicella (chicken pox) is required after 4th birthday.
6. Hepatitis B series (2 or 3 doses)
7. They also need at least one dose of the **pneumococcal conjugate vaccine** on or after their first birthday.

Please note: Children between the ages of 6 months to 59 months attending a licensed child-care center or preschool facility on or after September 1, 2008 are required to receive at least one dose of **Influenza vaccine** between **September 1st and December 31st** of each year.
